A letter was received by the Planning Board Chairperson, Shari Miller with a recommendation on behalf of Southern Chautauqua Federal Credit Union.

“The Town of Dunkirk Planning Board met at the Town Hall on Wednesday, February 24, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. to review the site plan application and relevant paperwork submitted by Southern Chautauqua Federal Credit Union. Chairperson Miller, Members Brandt, Lyford, and price were all in attendance. The requested action was presented by Larson, Karle Architects and Eco Strategies Engineering and Surveying to convert the existing “Bob Evans” building located at 3877 Vineyard Dr. in the Town of Dunkirk into a credit Union with office spaces, a teller line, a walk-up ATM, and a 3-bay drive thru. The Site plan was approved at the February 24, 2021 meeting by the Planning Board with a unanimous vote with no stipulations. The Town of Dunkirk planning Board recommends the Town Board approve the site plan at their next meeting.” Signed by Planning Board chairperson Shari Miller.
