Supervisor Purol stated the purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comment on the Site plan for Joshua Hudson, 3732 New Road for an addition onto existing business.

The Town Board was in receipt of written report of the Planning Board recommending approval of the project with four conditions:

- 1 - The current application should be corrected for errors including the variance permit.
- 2 - That information regarding his SEQR paperwork is submitted to the Town Board.
- 3 - Manufacturer specs are submitted regarding noise pollution - muffler.
- 4 - Documentation must be included for the town board showing the co-joining of lots.

Mr. Hudson reviewed the specs regarding the noise pollution and muffler. Code Enforcement Officer reviewed SEQR on file and found it to be complete. Arrangements with assessor to adjoin the lots.

With no further questions or concerns Councilman Penharlow made a motion to close the public hearing. (6:25 p.m.) The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.
