G. Jay Bishop MD was first elected to the Town Council in 2015

He has been a Town of Dunkirk resident since 1999 and is presently employed by the UPMC health care system as a vascular medicine specialist with offices in Western New York and Northwestern PA. He is the Division Chief of Vascular Medicine at the UPMC Heart and Vascular Institute at UPMC Hamot and serves the Medical Director for the Vascular Lab at the Heart and Vascular Institute and the Regional Vascular Labs.
