

## **Richard Purol, Supervisor**

Supervisor Purol began his service to the Town of Dunkirk in 1980 as a member of the Planning Board. He served as the Planning Board Chairman from 1988 to April of 2000 and as a Zoning Board Member from 1985 until 2000 when he was appointed to be a Councilman. After 4 years on the board, Supervisor Purol was appointed Deputy Supervisor in January of 2004. He was elected as Town Supervisor in November of 2005 and began his fourth term as Supervisor in January of 2018.

During his tenure as Town Supervisor, Mr. Purol has served as Public Works Director and East Lake Road Sewer District Director, positions to which he was appointed in 2015.

He is currently the Co-Chairman of Chadwick Bay Regional Development and is a member of the North County Water District and the Joint Operations Group.

A member of the East Dunkirk Volunteer Fire Company since 1972 he served as Fire Chief from 1983-1984 and is currently serving as the company's financial secretary.

Supervisor Purol is a proud veteran of the Army and served from 1971-1975. He is active in the First United Methodist Church where he holds the position of Head Trustee.

He resides in Town of Dunkirk with his wife Bonnie. He also has two children and four grandchildren who are residents of the Town.
