Supervisor Purol stated the purpose of the Public hearing was to discuss the proposed Town Budget in the amount of \$ 1,096,220 including special districts of \$280,158. The amount of tax to be raised for General Fund was \$38, 459.00 and for the Highway Fund \$37,807.00. The proposed budget would generate a tax rate of .71 per thousand of assessed value.

With no questions, comments or concerns, a motion was made by Councilman Penharlow, to close the public hearing at 7:09 p.m. The motion was seconded by Councilman Pagan and carried.
