Supervisor Purol informed those present that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comment regarding the West Dunkirk Fire Protection Contract for 2020.

The requested amount was \$ 75,123 .00 a 1.93 percent increase over last year generating a tax rate \$1.96 per thousand of assessed value.

Adam Resienweber, President for the Fire Company gave board members an overview of proposed budget. The budget line for personal equipment had been reduced because they have been updating their equipment over the past couple of years. Two new budget lines were added. One line under truck and equipment for annual hose testing and another listed as capital for a brand-new standby generator.

Councilman Pagan thanked the department for their time and dedication.

On motion of Councilman Penharlow the public hearing was closed at 6:27 p.m. The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.
