NORTH COUNTY WATER

Supervisor Purol reported that monthly meetings were held on November 21st and December12th. At the last meeting there was discussion about a problem with water volume at Athenex. Board members passed a resolution for North County to support in assisting the efforts of Athenex Engineers and Contractors and the City of Dunkirk Water Department to ensure proper water flow volumes to the Athenex complex in the Town of Dunkirk.

CORRESPONDENCE

Received a letter from Solar Liberty regarding a solar project owned by the Ball Family at 3751 Williams St. in the Town. The letter further stated that it was the intent of the State of New York for this system to be exempt from real property taxation with the support of the Town of Dunkirk. Supervisor Purol stated the Town opted out of the exemption from taxation. The town clerk will check to make sure the local law was adopted.

APPOINT DEPUTY REGISTRAR OF VITAL RECORDS

Councilman Walldorff made a motion to appoint Kyle Bentley as Deputy Registrar for 2020. The motion was seconded by Councilman Pagan and carried.

APPOINT TAX COLLECTOR/DEPUTY TAX COLLECTOR

Councilman Pagan made a motion to appoint Jean Crane as Tax Collector and Kyle Bentley as Deputy Tax Collector for 2020. The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.

SEASONAL TO PERMANENT POSITION IN HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Motion was made by Councilman Penharlow to appoint Robert Nichols to a full-time position in the highway department effect January 1, 2020. The motion was seconded by Councilman Pagan and carried.

ADJUST FUND BALANCE

Councilman Pagan made a motion to authorize the Supervisor to adjust budget amounts to meet the requirements of the New York State Department of Audit and Control. The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.

PRIVATE WATERLINES FOR ROBERTS ROAD

Supervisor Purol stated that property owners on Roberts road who had a well would be required to put in a meter; meter pit and install a pressure valve in the home. Proper owners with existing waterlines would be hooked up (unless their line is bad) to the new line at the shutoff and would also be required to install a pressure valve. Property owners would be responsible for the cost of the meter and meter pits.

APPROVE AMMENDED MAP PLAN BENNETT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

A motion was made by Councilman Pagan that the Town Board accept and files the amended map plan report of Clark Patterson Lee licensed engineers in the State of New York prepared at the request of the Town Board amending the 202-b proceeding for the Bennett Road Improvement District increasing the maximum amount to be expended to \$1,766,000. The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.

ORDER CALLING PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD JANUARY 21, 2020 INCREASING THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT TO BE EXPENDED FROM \$1,533,000 TO \$1,766,000

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Dunkirk, County of Chautauqua, State of New York, on behalf of the Bennett Road Water District in said Town, has requested CPL, licensed engineers in the State of New York, to prepare a Map, Plan and Report for the increase and improvement of facilities of the District consisting of construction of approximately fifteen hundred (1,500) linear feet of water main running from Arrowhead Drive easterly to Bennett Road, and then south on Bennett Road to an existing fire hydrant, along with an additional ten thousand (10,000) linear feet of eight inch water main, running southerly from the Town of Dunkirk – City of Dunkirk line along Bennett Road to the New York State Thruway lands, including water main lines to be placed on Williams Street East, together with all the lands, rights in lands, furnishings, equipment, machinery, and apparatus required therefore, and pursuant to the direction of the Town Board, CPL Engineers completed and filed with the Town a Map, Plan and Report for said increase and improvement of facilities of the Water District at an estimated maximum cost of One million, five hundred, thirty-three thousand dollars (\$ 1,533,000); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Dunkirk duly adopted a Resolution and Order after a Public Hearing in the above entitled proceeding on April 5, 2016, authorizing the expenditure of One million, five hundred, thirty-three thousand dollars (\$1,533,000) for said improvement of the water system as recited therein; and

WHEREAS, due to generally increased costs of labor and materials, the maximum amount now proposed to be expended for said improvement of the water system in said District is One million, seven hundred, sixty-six thousand dollars (\$1,766,000) being an increase of Two hundred, thirty-three thousand dollars (\$233,000) all as recited in an amended Map, Plan and Report by CPL dated December 2019; now, therefore, be it

ORDERED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 202-b of the Town Law, a further hearing be held in this matter at a meeting of the Town Board to be held at the Town Hall, 4737 Willow Road in the Town of Dunkirk on January 21, 2020 at 6:30 P.M. to consider an increase in the maximum amount to be expended for said improvement of facilities of the Bennett Road Water District from One million, five hundred, thirty-three thousand dollars (\$1,533,000) to One million, seven hundred, sixty-six thousand dollars (\$1,766,000), and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same, and for such other action on the part of the Town Board with relation thereto as may be required by Law;

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Town Clerk publish Notice of said Public Hearing and post on the sign board of the Town pursuant to the Town Law of the State of New York, a copy of this

Order, a first publication thereof and posting to be not less than 10, nor more than 20 days prior to the date of such Public Hearing;

FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of the Amended Map, Plan and Report prepared by CPL Engineers is filed in the office of the Town Clerk and available for inspection at said office.

Duly moved by Councilman Pagan to adopt resolution calling for Public Hearing on January 21, 2020. The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.

SCHEDULE ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

Councilman Pagan made a motion to schedule the Organizational meeting for 2020 on January 2, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.

ADJOURNMENT

With no further business, on a motion of Councilman Pagan seconded by Councilman Penharlow the meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m. Carried unanimously.
