Supervisor Purol stated the purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comment on the proposed project for the East Dunkirk Fire Department.

The Town Board was in receipt of the written report of the Planning Boards recommendations for the project.

Code Enforcement Officer Ryan Mourer stated that one of the recommendations was to confirm that the fire department plans for the discharge of storm water from the roof had DEC approval. In discussions with Jim Vogel from the DEC he did not see a reason to write a letter of approval and Ryan agreed with him. All other requirements recommended by the planning board had been met and the project was ready to move forward. Once a contractor was selected a building permit would be issued.

With no further questions or concerns Councilman Penharlow made a motion to close the public hearing. (6:43 p.m.) The motion was seconded by Councilman Walldorff and carried.
