Deputy Supervisor Penharlow informed those present that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comment regarding the West Dunkirk Fire Protection Contract for 2022.

The requested amount was \$75,123.00 the same as the 2021 budget year.

Adam Reisenweber, President for the Fire Company gave board members an overview of the proposed budget. He stated there were a few changes in some of the line items from the prior year. He stated they are looking to update the bathrooms and make them handicap accessible because as of right now they are not. He stated that they would like to do one this year and one next year. He told Board Members they are trying to update the building and get it more up to code. Adam further explained that the largest expense was replacing the tires for the trucks. He stated that there are a few members that need new interior gear this year as well.

A motion was made by Councilman Pagan, the public hearing was closed at 6:28 p.m. The motion was seconded by Councilman Bishop and carried.
